



Badminton Tasmania

Code of Conduct

2nd June 2020

1. Registered Individuals shall at all times conduct themselves in a manner that reflects favorably on Badminton, fellow Members and Badminton Tasmania. Failure to do so will render the Registered Individual liable to disciplinary action under this Code of Conduct.
2. All Registered Individuals shall conduct themselves in a manner that is free from any anti-social behaviour which prevents others from taking part in the activities of Badminton Tasmania. Badminton Tasmania strongly endorses the principle that every person (be they a spectator, player, club member, official, participant, administrator, coach, parent or member of the community) involved with Badminton should work to ensure:
 - a. inclusion of every person regardless of their age, gender or sexual orientation;
 - b. inclusion of every person regardless of their race, culture or religion;
 - c. opportunities for people of all abilities to participate in the sport and develop to their full potential;
 - d. respect is shown towards others, their club and the broader community;
 - e. a safe and inclusive environment for all;
 - f. elimination of violent and abusive behaviour; and
 - g. protection from sexual harassment or intimidation.

Registered Individuals that fail to meet these standards may be subject to action by Badminton Tasmania.
